General:

Application No. 18336 was filed to support Desert Land Entry No. Nevada-046513.

A protest to the granting of this application was filed on June 2, 1960, by Ida Gandolfo on grounds that its granting will dry up the springs on her ranching property on which she claims vested water rights for irrigation purposes.

Opinion:

From previous field investigations in the Reese River Valley, and from the records in this office, it is our opinion that the granting of this application will not interfere with existing springs on Ida Gandolfo's ranch.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application No. 18336 is herewith overruled on grounds that its granting will not impair the value of existing rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.

A permit will be issued under this application on receipt of the statutory permit fee.
