R U L I N G

General:

The following protests were filed against the granting of this application:

- On August 1, 1961, by Charles W. Haas;
- On August 3, 1961, by A. L. Toulmin.

The well under this application was drilled prior to the date the application was filed. Interference tests on the well were made by this office in September, 1961. From the results of the tests, it is our opinion that a restricted permit can be issued under this application.

RULING

The protests to the granting of Application 19722 are herewith overruled on grounds that its granting will not impair the value of existing rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare. A permit, subject to the following restrictions, will be issued under this application on receipt of the statutory permit fee:

- (1) The area to be irrigated shall not exceed 1.0 acre;
- (2) The amount of diversion is limited to 0.33 c.f.s. not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet annually.
