
Applications 18870 and 18871 were filed in support of Desert Land Application Nevada-055486. On December 15, 1961, we were notified by the Bureau of Land Management, Reno, Nevada, that they had not taken action on the land applications. As of the date of this ruling, the applicant does not have control of the land on which he plans to place the water to beneficial use.

RULING

Applications 18870 and 18871 are hereby denied on grounds that the applicant does not have control of the land on which he plans to place the water to beneficial use and that its granting would be detrimental to the public welfare.
