R U L I N G

General:

A protest to the granting of this application was filed on November 17, 1942, by A. C. Florio.

The application was assigned to John Handley Hunter and Kathryn Hunter on August 4, 1958.

On May 9, 1962, we were advised by the Bureau of Land Management that, in allowing Desert Land Entry Nevada-055831 for the W $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 15, T. 20 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B.& M., they had precluded the applicant's grazing rights on the area covered by the Land Entry.

The proposed point of diversion under this application is located on an approved Desert Land Entry, and all grazing rights on the Entry have been precluded by the Bureau of Land Management.

RULING

Application 10831 is hereby denied on grounds that its granting would impair the value of existing rights and would be detrimental to the public welfare.
