Application 22356 was filed on December 10, 1964 for 2.0 c.f.s. of the waters of an underground source at a point in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 27, T. 11 N., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M. to be used for industrial and domestic purposes within the same subdivision as the point of diversion. The water is to be used for the oil drilling operations and for exploratory purposes and for future use in the event that oil production is developed.

On February 23, 1966, notice of permit fee was forwarded to the applicant. By letter dated February 25, 1966, the applicant informed this office that the well had been turned over to the Bureau of Land Management. The Bureau of Land Management was informed on March 1, 1966 of the required permit fee. No instrument of transfer has ever been submitted to transfer this application to the Bureau of Land Management. On March 24, 1966, the second notice of permit fee was forwarded to the applicant. On April 25, 1966 a third notice of permit fee was forwarded to the applicant via certified mail. No fee has ever been received under this application.

Ruling: This application is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to comply with the provisions of NRS 533.435.
