R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application No. 16472 was filed May 10, 1955, to appropriate 0.50 second-feet of water from an unnamed stream for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T. 13 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M. The place of use is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14 and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, all in T. 13 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M. Protest was filed September 23, 1955 by William and Elizabeth S. Rabe.

On August 29, 1966, a letter was sent to the Placerville Lumber Company by certified mail advising that this application was being considered for approval subject to a notice in writing from the Placerville Lumber Company within 60 days informing this office of intent to place the water under this application to beneficial use.

RULING

In accordance with NRS 533.375 requesting additional information, a letter dated August 29, 1966, was mailed to the Placerville Lumber Company by certified mail. A certified mail return card properly signed by addressee's agent was received in this office September 1, 1966.

Application No. 16472 filed May 10, 1955, by the Placerville Lumber Company is herewith denied on the grounds the applicant no longer intends to place the water under this application to beneficial use as indicated by failure to respond in writing within 60 days to letter dated August 29, 1966, requesting additional information.
