R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 7945 filed on December 12, 1926, by Bertrand Arambel for 0.6 c.f.s. of water from Arambel Spring to be diverted from a point within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 12, T. 25 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B. & M. is to be used for stock watering and domestic purposes from March 1st to November 30th of each year within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This application was protested on January 19 and on February 7, 1927, by Martin Etchemendy on grounds that there is no unappropriated water in the source and that the source spring is not located within the 40 acre subdivision described in the application.

Application 7945 was assigned to Jeanne Arambel on September 2, 1964, by the Decree of Distribution of the estate of Bertrand Arambel.


The Bureau of Land Management, by letter dated November 17, 1966, over the signature of James A. Beydler, Range Manager, informed the office of the State Engineer that the point of diversion and the place of use under Application 7945 are located within the individual grazing allotment of Ted Thompson. For this reason the Bureau of Land Management recommends denial of Application 7945.

RULING

Application 7945 is hereby denied on the grounds that the applicant does not own or control the land on which the water is to be diverted and put to beneficial use.
