An application for a well driller's license was received August 5, 1968, from Alfred G. Mattice. In accordance with the procedure of processing applications for well driller's licenses, notices for recommendations were mailed on August 5, 1968, to the following references submitted by the applicant:


A & B Contractors - Sparks, Nevada

Replies were received from A & B Contractors and F. H. Breider. On October 16, 1968, a letter was sent to Mr. Mattice informing him that only two of the persons or firms had returned the references. It was explained that he must have four favorable recommendations before the application could be favorably acted upon and that additional references could be submitted. The applicant has failed to submit additional references as requested and no further replies have been received from those already sent.

RULING

The application for a well driller's license by Alfred G. Mattice is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant did not have sufficient recommendations and that he failed to indicate sufficient interest in obtaining a well driller's license.
