R U L I N G

GENERAL:

An application for a well driller's license was received on December 18, 1970 with the statutory \$25.00 fee from Ralph A. Dimick. Receipt No. 3204 was issued on December 18, 1970 to the applicant.

Requests for references were forwarded to the persons listed on the application on December 18, 1970. References were received from three of the four persons listed on the application. The applicant was requested to submit additional names of persons having knowledge of his ability as a well driller by letters dated August 10, 1971 and October 7, 1971. No response was received from Mr. Dimick to either request for additional references.

The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board, at the December 17, 1971 meeting, recommended denial of the application for a well driller's license by Ralph A. Dimick on the grounds of an insufficient number of references have been reviewed and no response to requests for additional references.

Ruling

The application for a well driller's license filed by Ralph A. Dimick is herewith denied on the grounds that an insufficient number of references were received and that the applicant failed to indicate sufficient interest to obtain a well driller's license.
