GENERAL:

An application for a well driller's license was received on July 19, 1971 with the statutory \$25.00 fee from W. D. Fitzgerald. Receipt No. 3392 was issued July 19, 1971 to the applicant.

Requests for references were forwarded to the persons listed on the application on July 20, 1971. References were received from two of the five persons listed on the application. The applicant was requested to submit additional names of persons having knowledge of his ability to drill wells for the development of water by letter dated October 7, 1971. No response was received from Mr. Fitzgerald to this request for additional references.

The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board, at the December 17, 1971 meeting, recommended denial of the application for a well driller's license by W. D. Fitzgerald on the grounds of an insufficient number of references have been received and no response to requests for additional references.

Ruling

The application for a well driller's license, filed by W. D. Fitzgerald, is herewith denied on the grounds that an insufficient number of references were received to determine that the applicant has had sufficient training and experience to qualify as a well driller.
