General

An application for a well driller's license was received on May 3, 1972, with the statutory \$25.00 fee from Robert S. Robertson. Receipt No. 3433 was issued May 3, 1972, to the applicant. Requests for references were forwarded to the persons listed on the application on May 3, 1972.

By certified mail dated May 18, 1972, the applicant was advised that three references had been received to that date and requested two additional names of persons having knowledge of his experience as a well driller. This letter also notified the applicant that his application would be reviewed at the June 8, 1972, meeting of the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board.

By certified mail dated August 11, 1972, the applicant was again advised of the status of his application and notified of the September 8, 1972 meeting of the Advisory Board. No response has been received from the applicant to either certified letter. The Advisory Board reviewed the application of Robert S. Robertson at the September 8, 1972, meeting and recommended denial on the grounds that the applicant has not submitted the additional information requested.

RULING

The application for a well driller's license filed by Robert S. Robertson is herewith denied on the grounds that insufficient references were received to determine that the applicant has had sufficient training and experience to qualify as a well driller.
