R U L I N G

GENERAL:

An application for a well driller's license was received in this office in September 8, 1972 with the statutory \$25.00 fee from Carl E. Martin, 525 St. Louis Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada. Receipt No. 3627 was issued on September 8, 1972 to the applicant.

Requests for references were forwarded to four (4) persons as listed on the application on September 8, 1972. No responses were received to the requests for references. Three of the letters of inquiry were returned unclaimed.

Mr. Martin was advised by a letter, dated November 21, 1972, by certified mail, that no response for references had been received from the persons listed on the application and requested the applicant to submit four (4) names and addresses of persons having knowledge of his ability and experience as a well driller. This letter was returned unclaimed.

Mr. Martin was again advised by a letter, dated February 14, 1973, by certified mail, that no references have been received and requested the applicant to submit an additional four (4) names and addresses of persons having knowledge of the applicant's ability and experience as a well driller. This letter also advised Mr. Martin that his application would be reviewed by the Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board at Meeting No. 1-73 to be held in Las Vegas on March 9, 1973 and requested him to appear for an oral interview. This letter was also returned unclaimed.

The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board reviewed Mr. Martin's application at the March 9, 1973 meeting and recommended denial of the application by Carl E. Martin.

Ruling

The application for a well driller's license filed by Carl E. Martin is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit references and failed to appear for an oral interview before the Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board and therefore it cannot be determined that the applicant has sufficient knowledge and experience to qualify as a well driller.
