FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Patrick Jerold Meyers in the office of the State Engineer on June 27, 1990 together with the statutory filing fee of \$50.00. Receipt No. 10556 was issued to Stavely Water Wells for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on June 27, 1990. Four testimonials were enclosed with the applicaiton. The applicant was notified on August 28, 1990 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on October 11, 1990 at 1:00 P.M. in Carson City, Nevada. The certified mail was returned by the postal service and the letter was sent regular mail the first week of September.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Patrick Jerold Meyers on October 11, 1990.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Patrick Jerold Meyers is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
