FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Joe I. Salazar in the office of the State Engineer on July 21, 1989 together with the statutory filing fee of \$50.00. Receipt No. 10069 was issued to Joe I. Salazar Drilling, Inc. for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on July 21, 1989. References were received from four of the requests. The applicant was notified on December 13, 1989 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on January 12, 1990 at 2:00 P.M. in Las Vegas, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by Jody Cordova on December 18, 1989.<sup>1</sup>

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Joe I. Salazar on January 12, 1990.<sup>2</sup>

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Joe I. Salazar is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
