RULING

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Fred Varnau in the office of the State Engineer on April 29, 1993 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 11751 was issued to Fred Varnau for said filing fee.


The applicant was notified on June 25, 1993 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on July 15, 1993 at 1:00 P.M. in Carson City, Nevada.¹

The applicant appeared as scheduled and was examined by the Board. Based upon the applicant's responses to questions about the Regulation and drilling equipment and practices, the Board finds that the applicant failed to demonstrate a good knowledge of his experience as a well driller. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Fred Varnau on July 15, 1993.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Fred Varnau is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
