RULING

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Ronald W. Gatzke in the office of the State Engineer on July 18, 1989 together with the statutory filing fee of \$50.00. Receipt No. 10066 was issued to Gatzke Drilling for said filing fee.


The applicant was notified on September 8, 1989 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on October 5, 1989 at 9:00 a.m. in Carson City, Nevada.¹

The applicant appeared as scheduled and was examined by the Board. Based upon the applicant's responses to questions about the Regulation and drilling equipment and practices, the Board finds that the applicant failed to demonstrate a good knowledge of the Regulation and experience as a well driller. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Ronald W. Gatzke on October 5, 1989.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Ronald W. Gatzke is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
