RULING # 4104

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Tony James Freiman in the office of the State Engineer on March 7, 1991 together with the statutory filing fee of \$50.00. Receipt No. 10669 was issued to Sergent, Hauskins & Beckwith for said filing fee.


The applicant was notified on March 25, 1991 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on April 11, 1991 at 2:00 P.M. in Carson City, Nevada.¹

The applicant appeared as scheduled and was examined by the Board. Based upon the applicant's responses to questions about his drilling experience the Board finds that the applicant is not a hands-on driller and does not have at least two years drilling experience. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board advised the applicant that NAC 534.296 provided that experienced drillers could receive a temporary license as long as they were under the supervision of a licensed well driller. Then the Board recommended denial of the application of Tony James Freiman on April 11, 1991.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Tony James Freiman is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
