FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Virgil Welch in the office of the State Engineer on September 13, 1993 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 12250 was issued to Welch & Howell Drilling, Inc. for said filing fee.


Requests for four references were mailed on September 13, 1993. References were received from four of the requests. The applicant was notified on March 15, 1994 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on April 15, 1994 at 8:00 A.M. in Las Vegas, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by A.B. Wiewel on March 18, 1994.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Virgil Welch on April 15, 1994.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Virgil Welch is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
