FINDING OF FACT


An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was Filed by Richard Anthony Johns in the office of the State Engineer on March 22, 1994 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 12299 was issued to Diamond Well Drilling Company for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on March 22, 1994. A response was received from two of the individuals. The applicant was notified on June 23, 1994 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on July 14, 1994 at 8:00 A.M. in Carson City, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by Diane Stevens on June 28, 1994.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Richard Anthony Johns on July 14, 1994.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Richard Anthony Johns is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
