RULING # 4532

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Steven R. Dimick in the office of the State Engineer on May 22, 1996 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 13477 was issued to V. H. Dimick for said filing fee.

The applicant was notified on September 13, 1996 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well drillers' Advisory Board on October 11, 1996 in Las Vegas Nevada. He appeared as scheduled and scored 67 on the written examination.<sup>1</sup> A score of 70 is passing.

The applicant was notified on December 19, 1996 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on January 17, 1997 in Las Vegas, Nevada. He appeared as scheduled, scored 73 on the written examination, and failed to correctly identify a location on a topographic map.<sup>1</sup>

The applicant was notified on March 18, 1997 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on April 11, 1997 in Las Vegas, Nevada.<sup>1</sup>

The applicant appeared as scheduled and passed Parts I and II of the examination. Based upon the applicant's responses to questions about the Regulation and drilling equipment and practices, the Board finds that the applicant failed to demonstrate a good knowledge of the Regulation and experience as a well driller. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Steven R. Dimick on April 11, 1997 because this was the third time Mr. Dimick was scheduled and didn't pass the examination.<sup>2</sup>



RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Steven R. Dimick is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
