RULING #5114

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Michael Boyd in the office of the State Engineer on May 29, 2001, together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 16291 was issued to Layne Christensen for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on May 31, 2001. References were received from all of the requests. The applicant was notified on January 18, 2002, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on February 15, 2002, at 8:30 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by Tamie Deblit on January 24, 2002.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Michael Boyd on February 15, 2002.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC § 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of Michael Boyd is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
