FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Bryan Blackerby in the office of the State Engineer on November 15, 2010, together with the statutory filing fee.¹

Requests for four references were mailed on November 15, 2010. Responses were received from two of the requests. The Applicant was notified on January 12, 2011, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on February 10, 2011, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas. The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Bryan Blackerby on February 10, 2011.²


CONCLUSION

The State Engineer concludes that the Applicant failed to notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear as scheduled as required in the NAC § 534.282, (2) (a).

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board and the application of Bryan Blackerby is herewith denied pursuant to NAC 534.282 (2)(a) that the Applicant failed to notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear.
