RULING

GENERAL

130
Application 7045 was filed February 8, 1924, by Cooper and Uniacke and Olive Cooper to change the point of diversion of waters heretofore appropriated under Permit 5207. This application is to change the point of diversion of 4.0 cfs of the waters of Pleasant Valley Creek from the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 12, T. 29N., R. 38E., to the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 11, T. 28N., R. 38E., MDB&M.

The application was protested by Sylvain Siard and Blanche Siard on April 21, 1924, on the grounds that the protestants have a prior vested right to these waters and also prior applications filed for waters from Pleasant Valley Creek.

No subsequent action was taken on Application 7045 until December 28, 1967, when the applicant was given 30 days in which to express a desire that the application be processed.

Service could not be secured on the applicant at the address of record in this office.

RULING

Application 7045 is denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit information as requested, and action without such information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
