General:

Application 21707 was filed December 26, 1963 to appropriate 5.4 c.f.s. of water for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as being within SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 18, T. 18 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M. and the place of use is 160 acres located within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 18, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 19, T. 18 N., R. 60 E., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M.

This office was informed by the Bureau of Land Management, by letter dated May 31, 1968, that the proposed place of use under this application was vacant public land and there were no pending land entries applications on this land.

Opinion:

It is the opinion of this office that the granting of an application where the applicant does not own or control the land on which he plans to place the water to beneficial use would be detrimental to the public welfare and not in the best public interest.

RULING

Application 21707 is herewith denied on the grounds that the granting of this application would be detrimental to the public welfare and not in the best public interest.
