RULING

GENERAL:

Application 135 was filed June 23, 1906 by C. J. Ernst, for all the flow of "Certain Springs" at the head of Spanish Belt Canyon for mining, milling, and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion was not described on the application. The proposed place of use is at and near Manhattan.

A letter dated July 26, 1968, was sent by certified mail, to the applicant at the best available address, requesting additional information. This letter was returned stamped "No such post office in said state", by the Post Office Department. It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 135 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the requested information necessary before a permit can be issued under this application, and that the granting of this application without said information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
