Application 6322 was filed November 10, 1920, by Orlando Pace for .5 c.f.s. of water for irrigation and domestic purposes. The proposed source is springs on a Homstead Entry and the point of diversion is described as being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 4, T.31N., R.52E., M.D.B.&M. The 50 acres described under the place of use are within the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$, all of Sec. 4, T.31N., R.52E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent by this office under certified mail to the applicant on August 12, 1968, requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this Application. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department stamped: "Unknown." It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of a current mailing address.

RULING

Application 6322 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this Application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
