RULING

GENERAL:

Application 10297 was filed September 20, 1938, by Pacific Placers, Inc., to appropriate 20.0 cfs of water from Duck Creek for mining purposes. The proposed points of diversion are described as follows: NW $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 15, SE $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 14, SE $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 24, all in T31N., R43E., MDB&M. The proposed place of use was described as the N $\frac{1}{2}$ Sections 23 and 24, all of Section 13, 14 and 15, T31N., R43E., MDB&M.

A letter dated August 16, 1968, was forwarded by certified mail to the best available address for the applicant, requesting additional information before a permit could be issued under this application. A reply dated September 4, 1968, was received from the law office of Walter M. Gleason. This letter states that the applicant corporation became defunct many years ago and that the mining project was abandoned. The letter to the applicant was sent in care of Walter M. Gleason as the best available address. It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 10297 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their successors in interest failed to submit the requested information and the granting of a permit without said information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
