R U L I N G

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Application 6504 was filed July 1, 1921, by George W. Malone for 80.0 c.f.s. of water for irrigation and domestic purposes. The proposed source is underground waters within Sections 11, 14, 23, 26, 15, 22, 27; and 13, T.13N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M., and the point of diversion is in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 2, T.13N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M. The 8,000 acres described under the place of use are Sections and portions of Sections 1, 2, 11, and 12, T.13N., R.25E., Sections 4, 5, 6 and 7, T.13N., R.26E., Sections 25, 26, 35 and 36, T.14N., R.25E., Sections 29, 30, 31, and 32, T.14N., R.26E., and N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T.13N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent by this office by certified mail to the applicant on August 23, 1968, requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. A letter was received in this office September 11, 1968, from the Walker River Irrigation District by H. E. Rowntree, Manager. He stated that the Lyon County Drainage District No. 1, the name under which the application was made, has long been abandoned. He further states that the place of use under Application 6504 is being irrigated under the terms of the Walker River Irrigation District, and since there is no further interest in Application 6504, the District recommends it be cancelled.

RULING

Application 6504 is herewith denied on the grounds the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
