GENERAL:


Application 5515 was filed on May 24, 1919 by Philip W. Baker to change the place of use of 1.0 c.f.s. of water for irrigation purposes. The proposed source is Lehman and Baker Creeks and is to be diverted near the center of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 11, T. 13N., R. 70E., M.D.B.&M. The 135 acres to be changed are described as being within the S $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , N $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 12, T. 13N., R. 70E., M.D.B.&M. The 100 acres proposed to be irrigated are described as being within the N $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , N $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 12, T. 13N., R. 70E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent by this office by certified mail to the applicant on August 8, 1968, requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. A return receipt card signed by Betty Baker was returned to this office on August 14, 1968.

RULING

Application 5515 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application, without the information requested, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
