GENERAL:


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Application 7105 was filed by A. C. Aiken on April 30, 1924, for permission to appropriate 0.10 c.f.s. of water from Mule Springs Nos. 1 and 2 for stockwatering purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 15, T. 22 S., R. 57 E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 16, T. 22 S., R. 57 E., M.D.B.&M. This Application covers the watering of 600 head of cattle.

A letter dated September 12, 1968, was sent by certified mail, to the best available address for the applicant, requesting information necessary before a Permit could be issued under this Application. This letter was returned stamped: "Insufficient Address - Addressee Unknown" by the Post Office Department. It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 7105 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the requested information and that the granting of a Permit under this Application without said information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
