GENERAL:


Application 4882 was filed on January 31, 1918 for 0.26 cfs of water for mining purposes. The proposed source is Bourne Gulch and is to be diverted S. 70° 30' 10" E., 5,515.67 feet from U.S.L.M. No. 230. The place of use is the same as the point of diversion.

A letter was sent to the applicant on September 24, 1968 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The letter was returned by the Postal Department stamped, "unclaimed". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successor in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 4882 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successor in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application without the information requested, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
