RULING

GENERAL:

Application 8681 was filed on August 29, 1928, for stockwatering (5,000 sheep) purposes. The proposed source is Overland Spring No. 2 and is to be diverted in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33, T24N., R55E., MDB&M. The place of use is in the same subdivision.

Application 8682 was filed August 29, 1928, for stockwatering (5,000 sheep) purposes. The proposed source is Rock Springs, and is to be diverted and used in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 29, T24N., R55E., MDB&M.

Application 8683 was filed August 29, 1928, for 05 cfs of water for stockwatering purposes. The proposed source is Cottonwood Creek and the point of diversion and place of use are described as being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20, T24N., R55E., MDB&M.

Application 8684 was filed August 29, 1928, for 05 cfs of water for stockwatering purposes. The proposed source is Overland Spring No. 1 and is to be diverted in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33, T24N., R55E., MDB&M. The place of use is within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33, T24N., R55E., MDB&M. and the


Application 8690 was filed September 7, 1928, for 05 cfs of water for stockwatering purposes. The proposed source is Jaurequito Well No. 3 and the point of diversion and place are located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T18N., R57E., MDB&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant on October 7, 1968, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action would be taken on this application. A return receipt signed by John Jauraquito was received in this office October 14, 1968. No further correspondence has been received in this office regarding this letter.

RULING

Applications 8681, 8682, 8683, 8684 & 8690 are herewith denied on the ground that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of these applications without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
