GENERAL:



Application 17981 was filed on May 8, 1959 for 2.5 c.f.s. of water for irrigation and domestic purposes. The proposed source is underground and is to be diverted in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, T. 14 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M. The 80 acres described under the place of use are within the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 34, T. 14 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant on November 1, 1968 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The letter was returned by the Postal Department stamped, "vacant." It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 17981 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application without the information requested, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
