GENERAL:


Application 15764 was filed on August 11, 1964 for 2,000 ac. ft. per annum of water for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The proposed source is Hamblin Valley Wash (flood waters) and is to be diverted in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14, T. 9 N., R. 70 E., M.D.B.&M. The 500 acres described under the place of use are within Lot 17, Section 24; W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25; Lots 4, 5, 6, 7, 15, 16, Section 25 all in T. 10 N., R. 70 E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant on October 11, 1968 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The letter was returned by the Postal Department stamped, "Moved, not forwardable". It is the responsibility of the applicants or their successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 15764 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application without the information requested, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
