GENERAL:


Application 9220 was filed on January 24, 1930 for 1.0 cfs of water for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The proposed source is Red Rock Spring No. 5 and is to be diverted in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 15, T. 28 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

A letter was sent to the applicant on October 11, 1968 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. A return receipt card signed by W. H. Settlemeyer for J. L. Hylton was received in this office on October 14, 1968.

RULING

Application 9220 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application without the information requested, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
