GENERAL:

Application 8132 was filed on May 13, 1927 for 100 c.f.s. of water for power purposes (40,000 horsepower). The proposed source is Cleve Creek and is to be diverted in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20, T. 16 N., R. 66 E., M.D.B.&M. The works are to be located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T. 16 N., R. 66 E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent to the applicants on December 13, 1968 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The letter was returned by the Postal Department stamped, "Unclaimed and addressee unknown". It is the responsibility of the applicants or their successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 8132 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application without the information requested, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
