R U L I N G

GENERAL:

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Application 8989 was filed by the W. T. Jenkins Company to appropriate 0.5 c.f.s. of water from Coon Creek Spring No. 1 for stockwatering (15,000 sheep and 1,000 cattle) and domestic purposes from January 1 to December 31 of each year. The point of diversion and place of use are described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5, T. 37 N., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M. Protest to the granting of this application was filed on August 7, 1929 by S. Rodwell Meyer.

A letter was sent to the applicant on January 2, 1969 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 8989. The certified mail return receipt card was returned to this office on January 6, 1969.

RULING

Application 8989 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest, have failed to submit additional information and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
