GENERAL:

Application 9353 was filed by Clarence and Dan Glaser on October 18, 1930 to appropriate 1.0 c.f.s. of water from an unnamed spring for stockwatering for 600 cattle and 100 horses from January 1 to December 31 of each year. The point of diversion and the place of use are described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, T. 38 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M. Protests to the granting of this application were filed on January 7, 1931 by the F. W. Noble and Smith Sheep Co. and also on January 7, 1931 by the H. Moffat Co.


Application 9354 was filed by Clarence and Dan Glaser on October 18, 1930 to appropriate 1.0 c.f.s. of water from an unnamed spring for stockwatering for 600 cattle and 100 horses from January 1 to December 31 of each year. The point of diversion and the place of use are described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, T. 39 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B.&M. Protests to the granting of this application were filed on January 7, 1931 by the F. W. Noble and Smith Sheep Co. and also on January 7, 1931 by the H. Moffat Co.

A letter was sent to the applicants on January 2, 1969 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application Nos. 9353 and 9354. The certified mail return receipt card was received in this office on January 6, 1969.

RULING

Application Nos. 9353 and 9354 are herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their successors in interest have failed to submit additional information and the approval of these applications without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
