R U L I N G

GENERAL:

53 Application 8898 was filed by Pete Abadie on May 3, 1929 to appropriate 0.2 c.f.s. of water from Stump Spring for stockwatering (10,000 sheep) and domestic purposes from January 1 to December 31 of each year. The point of diversion and place of use are described as within Lot 2 Section 2, T. 31 N., R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M. An informal protest to the granting of this application was filed on March 30, 1930 by C. H. Rand.


Application 8901 was filed by Pete Abadie on May 11, 1929 to appropriate 0.5 c.f.s. of water from Stump Basin Creeks for stockwatering (10,000 sheep) and domestic purposes from January 1 to December 31 of each year. The point of diversion and place of use are described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 3, T. 31 N., R. 52 E., M.D.B.&M. Protest to the granting of this application was filed on June 22, 1929 by the Central Pacific Railway Company and withdrawn on January 2, 1931.

A letter was sent to the applicant on January 6, 1969 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on application nos. 8898 and 8901. The certified mail return receipt card was received in this office on January 8, 1969.

RULING

Application nos. 8898 and 8901 are herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest have failed to submit additional information and the approval of these applications without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
