RULING

GENERAL:

Application 5939 was filed by L. L. Redden on January 6, 1920, to appropriate 1.5 cfs of water from Deep Canon Creek for irrigation (160 acres) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 8, T42N., R59E., MDB&M. The place of use is described as within the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 9, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T42N., R59E., MDB&M. Protest to the granting of this application was filed by the Union Land and Cattle Company on February 24, 1920.

A letter was sent to the applicant on January 23, 1969, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 5939. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department marked "Unknown". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of his current mailing address.

RULING

Application 5939 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest have failed to submit additional information and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
