} RULING

FINDINGS

173A
The State Engineer finds that the water desired to be appropriated is within the area covered by a co-use agreement between Applicants, Fallini Bros., and the U. S. of America, Department of the Air Force, and is less than three miles south of the northern boundary of the Las Vegas Bombing and Gunnery Range and is a short distance from the principal access road into this area.

OPINION

It is the opinion of the State Engineer that the granting of a permit under Application No. 14486 would in no way expand the present use of Fallini Bros. in the area under co-use agreement, or would not cause any additional interference with the use of the Las Vegas Bombing and Gunnery Range by the Air Force.

RULING

The protest is overruled and a permit will be granted under Application No. 14486 upon receipt of the statutory permit fee.
