RULING

GENERAL:


Application 5254 was filed by John Jesse Martin on September 21, 1918, to appropriate 0.4 cfs of water from the West Walker River for irrigation (40 acres) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T10N., R23E., MDB&M. The place of use is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T11N., R23E., MDB&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant on March 18, 1969, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application 5254. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department marked "Unclaimed - addressee unknown". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of his current mailing address.

RULING

Application 5254 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest have failed to submit the information requested, and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
