GENERAL:

Application 9333 was filed on September 12, 1930, for 1.0 c.f.s. of water for irrigation and domestic purposes. The proposed source is an unnamed spring and is to be diverted in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 6, T.17N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M. The 120 acres described under the place of use are within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 6, T.17N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant on July 3, 1969, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The letter was returned by the Postal Department stamped: "Unclaimed". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 9333 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
