R U L I N G

GENERAL:

176 Application 5687 was filed on August 22, 1919, for 1.0 c.f.s. of water for irrigation purposes. The proposed source is Sam Thompson Creek and is to be diverted in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, T.31N., R.59E., M.D.B.&M. The 40 acres described under the place of use are within the N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 21, T.31N., R.59E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant on June 25, 1969, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The letter was returned by the Postal Department stamped: "No Such Post Office in State Named." It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successor in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 5687 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
