RULING

GENERAL:

179 Application 9262 was filed on May 23, 1930, for 0.5 c.f.s. of water for irrigation purposes. The proposed source is McIntosh Spring and is to be diverted in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T. 23 N., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M. The 25 acres described under the place of use are within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T. 23 N., R. 65 E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant on July 10, 1969, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The applicant was given 30 days in which to reply. A return receipt card signed by M. Rose was received in this office on July 14, 1969, and no reply was received within 30 days of that date.

RULING

Application 9262 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application without the information requested, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
