

IN THE MATTER OF PERMIT NO. 3222 FILED  
BY WILLIAM T. O'NEAL FOR PERMISSION TO  
APPROPRIATE WATER FROM SLOUGH NO. 1,  
ELKO COUNTY, NEVADA. }

R U L I N G

GENERAL:

177 Application No. 3222 was filed by William T. O'Neal on, December 26, 1914, for permission to appropriate 10.0 cfs of water from Slough No. 1 from Gibbs, Sam Weeks and Steele's Creeks for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 22, T. 35 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M. The place of use is described as 1280 acres located within the S $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 22, S $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 25, S $\frac{1}{2}$ , E $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and W $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 26, all in T. 35 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B.&M.

This permit was assigned down to R.O.M. Investment Company on April 25, 1962. The Proof of Beneficial Use was filed under this permit on January 21, 1919.

A letter requesting certificate fees was sent to the owner of record by certified mail on August 22, 1969. This letter was returned to this office stamped "addressee unknown". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Permit No. 3222 is herewith cancelled on the grounds that the owner of record failed to submit the statutory recording fees and the issuing of a certificate without said fees would not be in the public interest.
