R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 7833 was filed on July 31, 1926 for 0.50 c.f.s. of water for mining, milling and domestic purposes. The proposed source is Tungstonia Spring and is to be diverted in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 34, T. 21 N., R. 69 E., M.D.B.&M. This application was protested on November 28, 1926 by H. W. Parker.

A letter was sent to the applicant on August 7, 1969 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The letter was returned by the Postal Department stamped, "Return to writer". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 7833 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application without the information requested, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
