R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 3237 was filed on January 12, 1915 for 1.2 cfs of water from Smith Creek for irrigation (120 acres) and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 36, T. 13 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is described as NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and Lot 1, Section 31, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 32, T. 13 N., R. 61 E., M.D.B.&M. The permit was issued on September 16, 1915. The Proof of Beneficial Use was filed on June 12, 1919. A letter was sent to the owner of record on October 3, 1969 by certified mail requesting certificate fees. This letter was returned by the Postal Department stamped "moved, left no address".

It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Permit 3237 is herewith cancelled on the grounds that the owner of record failed to submit the statutory certificate fee.
