R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 6557 was filed by Dan Devaney on August 29, 1921, for permission to appropriate .25 c.f.s. of water from Rock Spring for stock watering and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion and place of use is described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14, T.42N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M.

A protest was filed under this application by Tom Etulain on October 8, 1921, and informal protests were filed by Parman and Valerdi on April 25, 1932, and by Parman Bros. on April 25, 1932. No action has been taken on this application since that time.

A letter was sent to the applicant by certified mail on March 24, 1970, requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. This letter was returned stamped: "Insufficient Address" by the Post Office Department.

RULING

Application 6557 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit the required information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application.
