GENERAL:

Application 9313 was filed by Charles Lunceford and Lyle Beeney on August 9, 1930, for permission to appropriate 0.5 c.f.s. of water from an unnamed spring for stock watering purposes. The proposed point of diversion and place of use is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 10, T.34N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.

Protests were filed under this application by Griswold-Henderson Livestock Co. on July 25, 1931, and by L. S. Carey on July 27, 1931.

A letter was sent to the applicants on April 8, 1970, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. This letter was returned to this office with the notation: "Sold ranch to Dahl" by the Post Office Department.

RULING

Application 9313 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their successors in interest failed to submit the required information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application.
